#### Water Conservation Tips:

- **Don't run the hose while washing your car:** Soap down your car with a pail of soapy water. Then use a hose just to rinse it off.
- **Water your lawn and other plants only when they need it:** A good way to see if your lawn needs watering is to step on some grass. If the grass springs back when you move, it doesn't need water.
- **Deep-soak your lawn:** When you do water your lawn, do it long enough for water to seep down to the roots, where it won't evaporate quickly and where it will do the most good.
- **Water during the cool parts of the day:** Less water is lost to evaporation when the ground and the air are cool. Early mornings are better than at dusk since it helps to prevent the growth of fungus.

#### Did you know???
