

Bicknell Town Budget Public Hearing

I.WELCOME/ROLL CALL

Mayor Noreen Johnson welcomed everyone and opened the Bicknell Town Public Hearing at 6:30 PM. Council members present were: Bryan Brinkerhoff, Steve Albrecht, Kerry Stevens, and Weston Johnson. Others in attendance were Kelsey Brinkerhoff, Carrie Brinkerhoff, Laura Lasco, Gregg & Ellen Anderson, Jim Dudelston, Scott Woolsey, and Carly Lansch.

II.Public Hearing-Budget

The 2022-2023 Budget was opened to make some changes, Bicknell Town Received two grants equaling \$83,350. Therefore, the fund balance appropriated needs to be decreased from \$77836.00 to \$15,069.00. The mayor asked if there was any question or comments about the changes. Kelsey explained what funds balance appropriated meant. There were no other questions. Steve made a motion to approve the changes to the 2022-2023 budget, which Bryan seconded. A roll call vote was called Councilmembers voting yes: Albrecht, Brinkerhoff, Stevens, and Johnson. The vote was unanimous. Motion carries.

The 2023-2024 Budget was reviewed the council members had previous work meetings and finalized the proposed budget. The mayor asked if there were any questions. Steve had a few and there was some discussion about his concerns and then the mayor asked if anyone else had any questions. There were none. Steve made a motion to approve the 2023-2024 budget, which Weston seconded. A roll call vote was called Councilmembers voting yes: Brinkerhoff, Albrecht, Stevens, and Johnson. The vote was unanimous. Motion carries.
