Unfortunately, we did not receive funding for flood prevention from the Community Project Funding Grant through Representative Christ Stewart's Office. Beautification Committee: The beautification committee submitted an application to the T-Mobile Hometown Grant. The application was for funding for the Main Street Beautification Project. Which included 10 decorative lampposts, 12 rectangular flowerboxes, and four metal signs. A welcome to Bicknell sign on the west side of town, two directional marker signs, and a sign for the community garden. The application was due the end of June and letters will be sent out the end of August letting us know if we were awarded the grant. Until then we are not having our monthly meetings. We invite you to submit ideas for our next project.
