No open running hoses and if you have any leaks, please fix them. If you do not own or rent a share of Fremont Irrigation water you may not use irrigation water.

The Town is still on Level 2 of the Culinary Water Management & Conservation Plan but that could change to Level 3 if things get worse.

### Bicknell Town Elections

### Water Conservation Tips:

- Tree root tips need water; the base of the tree doesn't. Water around the drip line, located directly under the circumference of the tree.
- Direct downspouts and other runoff towards shrubs and trees.
- Less grass and more shrubs, wildflowers, and rocks add curb appeal and saves water.
- Use a watering can to water potted plants or small areas. Watering with a hose wastes water.
- Adjust sprinklers so they don't spray sidewalks and driveways.
- Adjust your lawn mower to a higher setting. Longer grass shades root systems and holds soil moisture better.
- Water only in the early morning or evening when it's cooler.
- Mulch around plants reduces evaporation. Use a drip system to save even more water.
