Mayor Johnson has been working hard to secure a grant/loan with The Permanent Community Board (CIB) for road improvements throughout town. She went to a final meeting the beginning of October and was able to receive a grant for \$771,000 and a loan for \$193,000 for 10 years at 0.5%. The following are the roads that will be improved:

- 100 South between 200 East and 400 West
- 400 West between Main Street and 250 South
- 100 West between 100 South and 150 South
- 100 West between Main Street and 50 North
- 200 North between 300 West and 400 West
- 100 North between 400 West to 450 West

CANVASS 2021

Do you know what an election canvass is? It sounds like a candidate knocking on doors, but this is different. The final tally of all eligible ballots after an election is called the election canvass, also known as the certification of the election.

By state code, the election cannot be certified before seven days after the election and no later than 14 days after the election.

The elections are certified by the mayor and the Town Council.

Don't forget to turn in your ballot by November 2, 2021.
