

BICKNELL TOWN ORDINANCE 1996 - 5

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF
OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES IN THE TOWN LIMITS

PREAMBLE: The Town Council believes that the use of off-highway vehicles on the streets of Bicknell needs to be regulated.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Bicknell Town Council as follows:

Section 1: This ordinance applies to all streets and highways within the corporate limits of Bicknell Town.

Section 2: Pursuant to Section 41-22-10.3 of the Utah Code Annotated, as amended, all street and highways in Bicknell Town are hereby designated as open to off-highway vehicle use, except State Road 24.

Section 3: Person using off-highway vehicles in Bicknell Town must comply with all other restrictions set out in Title 41, Chapter 22, including but not limited to registration, compliance with traffic laws, vehicle equipment, protective headgear, licensing, and ect.

Section 4: Any violation of this ordinance will be a Class C misdemeanor.

Section 5: This ordinance shall take effect on the date of its being posted in three public places within Bicknell Town.
