

RESOLUTION NO.11-2-2017

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING LIMITING THE NUMBER OF FUTURE OUT-OF-TOWN CULINARY WATER CONNECTIONS UNTIL ADDITIONAL WATER SOURCE AND STORAGE CAPACITY CAN BE INSTALLED.

WHEREAS, the Bicknell Town culinary water system does not meet State of Utah Rules for Public Drinking Water Systems requirements for either source capacity or storage capacity; and

WHEREAS, there continues to be requests for additional water connections both inside and outside of town boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the town has first responsibility to supply water to those properties located inside the town boundaries; and


WHEREAS, it will take time for the town to acquire funding and make improvements to the system to increase source and storage capacities; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the town council to provide an adequate and dependable culinary water supply system to town and nearby residents.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BICKNELL TOWN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Effective upon adoption of this resolution by the Bicknell Town Council, additional out-of-town culinary water system connections will not be allowed until additional water source and storage capacities can be installed, or, this resolution is otherwise rescinded by the Bicknell Town Council.
