

**BICKNELL TOWN RESOLUTION #2-7-2019**

**A RESOLUTION CANCELLING A MORATORIUM ON NON-RESIDENT CULINARY WATER CONNECTIONS**

**WHEREAS:** Bicknell Town owns and operates a culinary water system, and

**WHEREAS:** There has been a Moratorium in place since November 2017 which stops the approval of any and all new non-resident connections to the culinary water system, and

**WHEREAS:** The purpose for the Moratorium was because of an emergency and lack of water supply from the springs on the mountain, and

**WHEREAS:** The springs have increased some in water production in recent weeks and months, and

**WHEREAS:** There have been applications submitted to Bicknell Town for new culinary water connections, and

**WHEREAS:** The Mayor and Town Council feel that allowing and approving some additional non-resident connections to the culinary water system will not adversely affect the water supply, and

**WHEREAS:** There is a project being proposed which is intended to redevelop water springs and/or drill wells in order to provide the culinary water system with the water that is both needed and allowed,

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF BICKNELL TOWN, WAYNE COUNTY, UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1: MORATORIUM ON NON-RESIDENT CULINARY WATER CONNECTIONS IS CANCELLED.**

As of the date of this Resolution, the Mayor and Town Council of Bicknell Town, Utah, may, but are not required to, authorize new non-resident connections to the Bicknell Town Culinary Water System.

**SECTION 2: AUTHORIZATION OF NEW NON-RESIDENT CONNECTIONS TO THE CULINARY WATER SYSTEM ARE NOT PROMISED OR GUARANTEED.**

Any and all future non-resident connections to the Bicknell Town Culinary Water System will be allowed, or not allowed, on a case by case basis. This determination will be made solely on the condition of the culinary water supply at the time of the request or application. Nothing herein is to be interpreted as a promise or guarantee that any particular request or application for a culinary water connection will be approved. If at any time the Mayor and Town Council

feel that the culinary water supply is short of that which is needed for the town, no further non-resident connections will be allowed and a Moratorium may be reinstated.


**SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE AND POSTING OF THIS RESOLUTION.**
