

**BICKNELL TOWN
RESOLUTION #2018-9-1**

A RESOLUTION RESTRICTING THE USE OF CULINARY WATER FROM THE
FIRE HYDRANTS IN THE BICKNELL TOWN CULINARY WATER SYSTEM.


WHEREAS: This resolution is made in accordance with Bicknell Town Ordinance #1992-1, Section 10.

WHEREAS: Fire District # 3, the Wayne County Fire District, has the right to use the water in the Bicknell Town Culinary Water System from the fire hydrants for fighting a fire within the boundaries of said system. There will be no charges for this service.


WHEREAS: No individual or group has the right to use water out of the fire hydrants in the Bicknell Town Culinary Water System for any purpose, without the permission of the Mayor and the Bicknell Town Council. If given permission by said Mayor and Council a meter will be attached to the hydrant and the person/group will pay for all culinary water used from the hydrant at the current culinary water rates.

WHEREAS: Any individual or group caught using culinary water from the fire hydrants within the Bicknell Town Culinary Water System without permission will be fined \$150 for the first violation and will double with each violation thereafter.

This resolution was passed on 10th day of September, 2018, by vote of the members of the Bicknell Town Council. This resolution becomes effective immediately upon posting.
