- I. OPEN MEETING/ROLL CALL  
Mayor Johnson called the meeting to order. Councilmembers present were Steve Albrecht, Gregg Anderson, and Weston Johnson. Kelsey Brinkerhoff, Scott Woolsey, Carrie Brinkerhoff, and Jim Dudleston were also present. Kerry Stevens was absent.
